



Position: **Nurse Practitioner**

Responsibilities:

- This position will primarily operate, providing clean needles to people who inject drugs.
- Register as the program's Limited Service Laboratory Director and the Expanded Syringe Access Program (ESAP).
- Educates clients on the Expanded Syringe Access Program (ESAP), including the rights and responsibilities for each new client, services available to clients, and other information as appropriate.
- Obtain information from clients to complete registration, observing clients returning used needles, distributing clean needles, collect and submit data of needles dispensed and returned on a monthly basis.
- Completes routine set up in advance of needle exchange program start time. Ensures rooms are adequately stocked, ensures door is unlocked at start time and waiting area is set up for clients to enter.
- Conducts weekly inventory for needle exchange program supplies and request orders as needed.
- Expanded Syringe Access Program (ESAP) will operate on Tuesday and Thursdays from 4:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. in the Turning Point Brooklyn's Education Center basement.
- Provide Nalaxone, and support staff that distribute Nalaxone under the license of the Nurse Practitioner. This will include working directly with clients, patient education, community outreach, community naloxone classes, and program support/administrative duties.
- Oversee and ensuring that all procedures and protocol are followed by Turning Point Brooklyn staff Quality Assurance program for rapid HIV/HCV testing.
- Ensure staff compliance with Article 27- F of the Public Health Law.

Qualifications Required:

- Master's Degree in Nursing,
- Valid New York State Nurse Practitioner license
- Experience in HIV/AIDS Programs, including Expanded Syringe Assess Program (ESAP)
- Bilingual (Spanish) Speaking is a plus.
