



Job Title: Psychiatric Nurse Practitioner (Certified in Psychiatry)
Program/Department: Brooklyn Community PROS
Reports to: Psychiatrist
Work hours: Part-time (6 hours/week)

Brooklyn Community PROS (Personalized Recovery Oriented Services) offers rehabilitation, counseling, therapeutic activities, and peer support each day to individuals living with severe mental illness. The program works to help program participants identify meaningful, personal life goals to help them become as self-sufficient as possible. Brooklyn Community PROS has been at the forefront of integrating evidence based practices and recovery into its service model.

Responsibilities:

- Provide Psychiatric Evaluations with Mental Status Exams and monthly psychiatric notes to consumers enrolled in Personalized Recovery Oriented Services (PROS) who seek on-site clinic services. Review and sign Individualized Recovery Plans.
- Provide medication management including prescription refills and medication education to all PROS participants.
- Collaborate with local pharmacies and medication companies as arranged by Program Director.
- Collaborate with R.N. to arrange laboratory tests as needed for medication levels, and urine toxicology for substance abuse in collaboration with Recovery Specialists and Supervisors.
- Evaluate need for consumer hospitalization or other emergency medical care, as needed.
- Plan for psychiatric coverage needs during absences and work with R.N. to assure IM injections as needed in her/his absence.
- Administer IM injections during R.N. absences

Qualifications Required:

- Certification as a Psychiatric Nurse Practitioner by the New York State Education Department;
- Experience with seriously and persistently mentally ill adults; Recovery and rehabilitation philosophy-oriented.
