Position Summary:

BCS Education & Youth Development provides after-school learning opportunities to children from low-income families, who attend some of New York City's lowest performing public elementary schools. The Compass afterschool program is offered every weekday from 8 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. at four public elementary schools located in Bedford-Stuyvesant and Brownsville Brooklyn for Summer Risings Program 2021.

Responsibilities:

- Implement hands-on multi-sensory lessons and activities to children which are provided in the context of academically stimulating lessons based on the Thematic Curriculum.
- Submit lesson plans to the Education Specialist for approval according to submission schedule.
- Plan lessons for field trips related to Thematic Curriculum.
- Participate in Curriculum and other Professional Development trainings as required.
- Use creative / innovative teaching strategies that enhance and encourage an increase in literacy skills and STEM.
- Work with the program Site Director and other staff to develop and plan culminating event presentations.
- Engage with parents as required by site director.
- Provided effective supervision to 10 students during classroom activities and transitions.
- Monitor and authorize parent / guardian pick up of children.
- Direct and work with Lead Teacher.
- Participate in agency wide groups and meetings as required
- Other tasks as may be required.

Qualifications Required:

- Bachelor's Degree required, Bachelor's Degree in Education field a plus.
- Experienced working with children K-5th grade
- Must enjoy working with children and able to pass a background check with NYC and NYS Department of Health and NYC Department of Education
- Experience working with youth in an afterschool or summer camp environment

- Current or former teacher. Background in STEAM, visual, performing arts or sports coaching a plus. Computer savvy in applications, video conferencing, and responding to emails
